How We Work

CALL to make an appointment for your initial interview:
314-580-3138

BRING:

- Driver's license or State I.D.
- Proof of residency in 63123* (utility bill, rent agreement) **or** Sponsorship letter from a Member Church
- Paycheck stub
- Social Security cards for **all** members of your household
- Food Stamps paperwork (if applicable)
- Medicare/Medicaid, SSI, and Social Security documents

APPLY

At your first visit, you will be interviewed to determine your eligibility and service level based on your family size and income.

SHOP

You will then "shop" in our pantry, accompanied by a volunteer. You are welcome to shop once every 2 weeks, by appointment.

*The ACFP serves all persons who demonstrate a financial need **and** live within our service area, or are sponsored by one of our member churches, regardless of race, creed, or nationality.

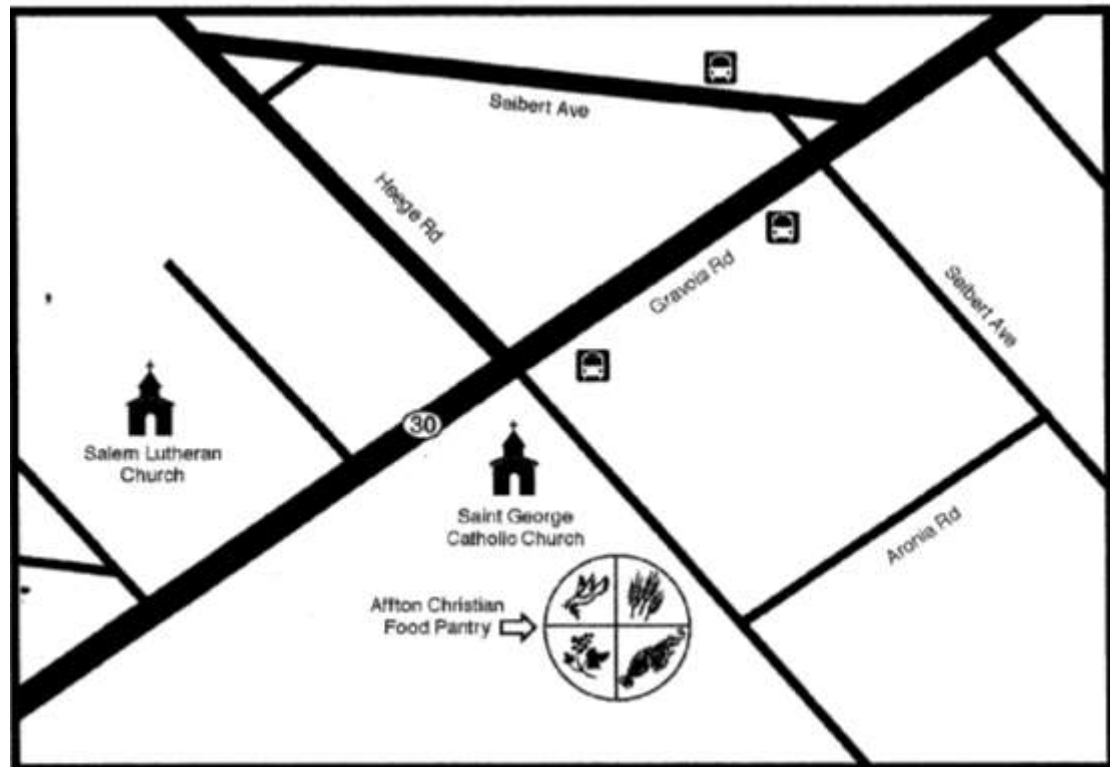
Hours of Operation
