## Little Brown Bag... BIG Difference

For the second year in a row, we supplied families with school-age children a supplemental “**Brown Bag**” each visit during spring break, summer, and Christmas break. These “Brown Bags” replace the breakfasts and lunches normally provided to students in our program through the Federal School Lunch program. When school breaks hit, families are faced with providing an extra 10 meals per week for each of their children.

**Kohl’s** department store partnered with us this year, sending a crew to fill **100+ Brown Bags** with more than **163,000 items** over 7 visits (with **Cure of Ars** picking up the 8<sup>th</sup> fill!). In addition to cereal, oatmeal, kid-friendly lunches and snacks, we filled the bags with toothbrushes and toothpaste, sunglasses, hand sanitizer, and small treats.



Kids love to get the bags, always digging right in to see what’s waiting for them. But, it’s the relief in the parents’ eyes that tells us the program meets a very important need for our families.

**Thank you, all**, who donated items specifically to the Brown Bag program, who support it financially, and especially those who volunteer to fill the bags for our students!

## Fill the Van

In January 2015, **Matt Miller** of **Send Me St. Louis**, a ministry of the **Lutheran Foundation of St. Louis**, conducted an “**Asset Mapping**” day for our Board, some volunteers, and supporters. As a result of the exercises that day, “**Fill the Van**,” was born to meet two important needs: 1) spread the word in the community about the ACFP and 2) keep our shelves full all year long.



Headed by Board Member, **Denny Eckert (New Apostolic Church)**, Fill the Van was off and running by late March. As of the end of October, this initiative, which brought our van to area churches and businesses for on-the-spot food drives, collected more than 14,000 items (food and personal care) and over \$1,200 in cash!
